

RiverGlass To Take Part in Event Management Framework Contract Awarded by DISA

Event Management Framework will Support Command and Control of Response to National Catastrophic Events

(WEST CHICAGO, IL) – February 25, 2007 - RiverGlass, Inc. announced today it will team with Science Applications International Corporation [NYSE: SAI] (SAIC) of San Diego, Calif. to support a contract from the Department of Defense, Defense Information Systems Agency for Advanced Systems & Concepts, Command and Control, Event Management Framework, Advanced Concept Technology Demonstration. SAIC is the prime contractor. RiverGlass joins five other advanced technology providers in the contract to develop an integrated solution for a national joint coalition event management response capability.

The project will utilize RiverGlass Recon™ open source intelligent directed Web search engine as a smart agent and the RiverGlass advanced analytics capabilities as the semantic services reasoning engine to support analysis of the myriad of data affecting an incident and for information exchange brokering. By addressing the areas of policy, operational concepts and technologies, the EMF will support Command Center Leaders in managing a comprehensive coordinated response to major incidents and events. Such operations other than war include response to a terrorism attack, natural disasters such as hurricanes, earthquakes, winter storms, forest fires, tsunamis, as well as a pandemic outbreak.

The systems will be deployed at and operated by the US Northern Command Joint Operations headquarters command center at Peterson AFB in Colorado Springs, Colo. USNORTHCOM's civil support mission includes domestic disaster relief operations that occur during fires, hurricanes, floods and earthquakes. Support also includes counter-drug operations and managing the consequences of a terrorist event employing a weapon of mass destruction.

"The EMF contract is recognition of the capabilities and power of the RiverGlass technologies." said Rick McNees, vice president of Business Development. "This contract builds upon and extends the use of our analytics from intelligence gathering to incident management and response. We are looking forward to a long and successful relationship with SAIC and their command customers."

Throughout the contract, RiverGlass and the project team will provide a spectrum of engineering, acquisition, implementation and operational sustainment support to branches of the military and federal agencies.
